

## Kindergartners are to bring supplies to their visiting appointment:

- Change of clothes (including underwear, socks, etc.) in large zip-lock bag; clothes & bag **LABELED** with child's name  
*(This is for paint spills and other accidents!)*
- 1 box crayons (8-count, large primary size)
- 1 pair of student scissors (labeled)
- 2 glue sticks (labeled)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (No batteries, please!)
- 1 dozen **sharpened** pencils
- 1 large eraser (separate from pencil)
- Colored pencils (in a labeled quart-size "Zip-loc" bag)
- Toothbrush in travel holder or head cover (labels on both)
- Toothpaste (labeled)

**We have containers to hold items, so no supply box is needed.**

**Please: NO backpacks.**

# First Grade students are to bring supplies to their visiting appointment or the first day of school:

## Grade 1

- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- 1 box of markers
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (not round points)
- 1 dozen pencils - sharpened
- 1 set colored pencils - sharpened
- 1 large eraser
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 ruler with inch and centimeter markings
- One 3-ring binder (1") with clear-view cover (so a picture can slip in)\*
- Five untabbed dividers with double pockets (3-hole punched)  
(e.g. Office Depot #409842)\*
- 1 sturdy "pocket folder" for Science

- 1) Be sure all jackets/sweaters and other personal belongings are clearly **LABELED**.

**Grades 6, 7, 8**

***Organization is the key! Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth graders will need to have with them at  
school every day:***

- 1 "Trapper Keeper" type notebook
- Book covers – **non-adhesive**; paper bags preferred
- 1 Ruler (6") (Inches & centimeters) – bendable preferred
- 1 set of colored pencils
- One zippered pencil bag that fits inside a notebook
- Pencils
- Notebook paper (wide rule)
- Ballpoint pen (blue or black)
- Highlighters (2 or 3 different colors)
- 1 scientific calculator (Texas Instruments - 34Multiview required)
- 4" x 6" white index cards (200) – loose, **not** perforated, **not** bound sets  
(Grade 6 & Grade 7/8 Research students)
- One 3-ring binder (1") with a clear view cover **for History** \*
- One 3-ring binder (3") with clear view cover **for Science** \*
- Graph paper (w/3 holes punched for **Math**)
- One 3-ring binder (2") with clear view cover for **Math (Grades 6, 7 & 8)**\*
- One 3-ring 2-pocket folder for **Math (Grades 6, 7 & 8)**\*
- 2 sets binder dividers (one for **Math**)\*
- Two single subject spiral notebook w/3 holes punched for **Math & homeroom (Grade 6)**\*
- Spanish Dictionary (paperback – **not** compact size) (**Grade 6**)
- Vox Spanish/English Dictionary*** (**not** compact size) (**Grades 7 & 8**)
- 501 Spanish Verbs*** (Christopher Kendris) or ***Barron's Spanish Verbs*** (**Grades 7 & 8**)
