

Kindergartners are to bring supplies to their visiting appointment:

- Change of clothes (including underwear, socks, etc.) in large zip-lock bag; clothes & bag **LABELED** with child's name
(This is for paint spills and other accidents!)
- One labeled small stuffed animal if your child wishes to have one at quiet time
- 1 pair of student scissors (labeled)

- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (No batteries, please!)
- Pencils (Brought from home or purchased at the school store)
- 1 eraser (separate from pencil)

- Toothbrush in travel holder or head cover (labels on both)
- Toothpaste (labeled)
